

Using and accessing manager command line

You get access to WCS manager CLI via SSH. To open it you can use a Linux-SSH command line client or any other, for instance, Putty.

```
ssh -p 2000 localhost
username: admin
password: admin
```

In production, change the username and the password to secure ones. Please refer to the WCS Manager Settings section to learn how to do this.

Type help in the command line to receive information on commands.

```
> help
Try one of these commands with the -h or --help switch:

NAME      DESCRIPTION
add        Add properties
grep       search file(s) for lines that match a pattern
start      Start command
save       Save commands
show       Use to retrieve info from server
update     Update property
loadtool   Configure/start load tests
remove     Remove property
call       Call commands
qa         Quality Assurance
node       manage server node
reload     Use to reload anything from server
watchdog   Watch Dog Manager
stop       Stop command
passwd     change password
egrep      search file(s) for lines that match a pattern
filter     a filter for a stream of map
man        format and display the on-line manual pages
help       provides basic help
repl       list the repl or change the current repl
```

For a detailed description of a command, you can type that command with the -h key or use the man command.

```
> node -h
usage: node [-h | --help] COMMAND [ARGS]

The most commonly used node commands are:
  restart      restart server node
  start        start server node
  stop         stop server node
```

```
> man node
NAME
    node - manage server node

SYNOPSIS
    node [-h | --help] COMMAND [ARGS]

PARAMETERS
    [-h | --help]
        Display this help message

COMMANDS
    restart
        Restart server node

    start
        Start server node

    stop
        Stop server node
```
