

Using and accessing command line

You can get access to core CLI via SSH on TCP port `2001`. To open it you can use a Linux OpenSSH command line client or any other, for instance, Putty.

```
ssh -p 2001 localhost
username: admin
password: admin
```

In production, change the username and the password to secure ones. The username can be changed in `database.yml` file, the password can be changed using command line.

[Public key authentication](#) is also supported.

Type `help` in the command line to receive information on commands

```
login as: admin
SSH server: Password authentication
Using keyboard-interactive authentication.
Password:
% help
Try one of these commands with the -h or --help switch:

NAME      DESCRIPTION
add        Add properties
call       Call commands
reload     Use to reload anything from server
stop       Stop command
passwd     change password
grep       search file(s) for lines that match a pattern
save       Save commands
show       Use to retrieve info from server
start      Start command
update     Update property
remove     Remove property
help       provides basic help
repl       list the repl or change the current repl
```

For a detailed description of a command, you can type that command with the `-h` key.

```
% update user -h
usage: update [-h | --help] user [-a | --active] <username>

    [-h | --help]    this help
    [-a | --active]  set active flag
```
